

Hamworthy Recreation Football Club was formed in 1948 as Hamworthy Engineering FC and played on the Sports Ground opposite the factory at Fleetsbridge in Poole (where the Tesco supermarket now stands). When the site at Fleetsbridge was sold to Tesco in the late 1980's the football, along

with the Sports & Social Club, moved to its current home at Magna Road.

At that time 'Hamworthy Engineering FC' were playing in the Bournemouth League (Division 1). The Club won the Bournemouth Senior Cup in the 1988-89 season, and after winning the Division One Championship in 1990/91 'The Rec' successfully applied to join the Dorset Combination League for season 92/93 when they finished 3rd. Success soon followed when the Club won a hatrick of Combination League Championships in 1993-94, 1994-95 and 1995-96.

'The Rec' have lifted the League Championship Trophy on another nine occasions, 2000/01, 2001/02, 2004/05, 2009/10, 2010/11, 2014/15, 2017/18, 2018/19 and 2021/22. The Club have won the League Cup on six occasions - 2000/01,2006/07, 2007/08, 2013/14, 2014/15 and 2021/22.

'The Rec' consider that their greatest achievement was in 1995, when not only did they win the League Championship, but also won the Dorset Senior Cup, defeating Weymouth Football Club from the Southern League by 3 goals to nil at Magna Road in the Semi-Final, and Poole Town FC, another Southern League team, 4 - 1 in the Final. The 2001-01 season saw the Club change its name to Hamworthy Recreation FC to reflect the name of their current headquarters. Our proud boast – we've never finished below 6th since Ham Eng joined the Combination in 1992/93.

When the Club won promotion to the Wessex League the Reserves moved to The Hampshire Development League, winning Div 1 at the first attempt and finishing a commendable mid table in 20223/24 having been promoted to the Premier Div.. For the 2024/25 season they applied for, and were granted, a place in the Dorset Premier League, in which the Club has such a rich history.

During 2022, with funding support from the Football Foundation and local sponsors' we managed to get the ground upgraded to have floodlights and a 50 Seat Stand and so have progressed to the Wessex League Division 1. We have a Development/Reserves Team, both as a feeder team from our Under 18's and upwards towards our First team.

We now have the following teams and Leagues:

- First Team in the Premier League of the Wessex League
- Reserves in the Dorset Premier League

Clanfield FC was formed in 1983 with the merging of Clanfield Seniors and Clanfield Boys Club to establish a single club for the area. In our relatively short history we have built up a strong infrastructure both on and off the pitch and this has enabled us to run teams ranging from boys and girls youth teams up to senior level.

Clanfield FC's home ground has been Peel Park since the club was formed with changes over the years to accommodate the league standards required to play at Hampshire level. Unfortunately, the restrictions at Peel Park mean that progression beyond the Hampshire Premier League required the 1st team to seek an alternative home to play at. In 2019 we agreed a groundshare arrangement with Havant & Waterlooville FC and started putting together plans to secure promotion into the Wessex League.

As a club, our most successful period to date was in the 90's winning the Portsmouth & District League at all levels then joining the Hampshire League in 1997. The club's biggest achievement came in the 1998/99 season with the club winning the Hampshire League Division 3 title and the Hampshire Intermediate Cup completing the double and making history for the club. The club briefly joined the Wessex League in early 2000's until the reformed Hampshire Premier League was introduced for season 2007/08 and that is where the club stayed until we finished 2nd in the 2022/23 season, securing our promotion to the Wessex League Division 1.

Our youth structure has a pathway through from our Colts sessions through to U18s, incorporating 23 youth teams playing in the Portsmouth Youth League, Mid Solent League and Hampshire Girls League. Our U23s and Reserves teams play in the Hampshire Combination and Development League while in 2022/23 we had our first Women's team enter the County Women's league. Our successful Weetabix Wildcats programme has helped create a thriving girls football section, with nearly half our youth members being female, with a number playing for both girls and mixed football teams.

31.8.24. Fareham Town 1 Hamworthy Rec 0

A goal in the second minute of stoppage time condemned Rec to their second league defeat of the season - and they will be gutted! This was a close, even game throughout and looked a nailed on goalless draw. Fareham had the better chances, but Rec had the better approach play. It was just the final ball that let them down. Despite the lack of goals both sides attacked and it was a good watch, but Rec switched off in the final minutes and it cost them.

Fareham had an early free-kick, easily collected by Callum Watson, in the Rec goal. Chris Long chased a long clearance, but fell after a tangle with a defender and Eddie Hodge fired inches wide, before the hosts almost scored, following a corner. Harvey Doe was the Rec saviour, with a header off the goalline. Aaron Roberts was impressive in midfield, for Rec and a clever move ended with a Long turn and shot wide. But the Creeksiders were having the better chances, with Jewell heading over a great cross from Cooper and the speedy Underhill setting up Woodward to fire over.

Rec forced a succession of corners, to no avail, before, right on the break, Jewell beat the Rec defence, but shot wide. HT 0-0.

Rec's best chance came at the start of the second half, when Roberts teed up Tom Cooper, who drilled his shot goalwards, only for home stopper, McCarthy to palm the ball over the bar. Hodge then produced some trickery on the left, but failed to find a blue shirt, before Underhill delivered a dangerous ball, only for Doe to come to Rec's rescue again.

Long was fouled by Kershaw, earning the home defender a yellow card, but Ben Cooper's free-kick was no problem for McCarthy. At the other end Watson produced a great tip over from Pates' effort, before the hosts missed a good chance, following a corner.

With Rec seemingly settling for a deserved point it all went wrong in stoppage time. A Kershaw free-kick from near the half-way line almost caught out Watson, with the Rec keeper managing to push the ball onto the bar, but a mistake gifted the ball back to Fareham and a cross from the right was bundled in from close-range by KESSACK, to clinch it for the hosts, on 90+2. FT 1-0.

Match Report by John Hutchings

27.8.24. Portland United 3 Hamworthy Recreation 4

Rec were on the right end of this seven goal thriller at Portland, to record their first league win of the season. It was an entertaining game throughout, with Rec racing into a two goal lead in the first ten minutes, then being pegged back to 2-2 at the break. The two goal lead was re-Instated on the hour, before the Blues completed the scoring in stoppage time.

Rec went in front on 7m, when Ben Cooper's free-kick to the far post found CHRIS LONG, who finished in style with a low shot across home keeper, Bruton. From the re-start Portland went close with a header from Borthwick just over. But on 9m Eddie Hodge initiated the move which saw Marcelo Rossi deliver a perfect cross from the right for LONG to power in a far post header, to give Rec a dream start.

Portland came back strongly and on 18m JENKINS drilled a low shot past Callum Watson, in the Rec goal, after the defence had failed to clear.

It was end to end action and George Deem headed a chance over, before home skipper Williams fired a long distance effort just wide. But Portland pressure paid off on 29m, when Rec gave the ball away, allowing BORTHWICK to race through and fire, low past Watson, for the equaliser. HT 2-2.

The action resumed two minutes into the re-start, when the tireless Long was brought down by the keeper, just inside the area. Up stepped skipper BEN COOPER to smash the spot-kick high into the roof of the net, for 2-3.

Rec were now on top, playing some impressive football and added a fourth, on 61m. Hodge sent over a pin-point cross from the right for DEEM to power in a header, from close-range. Long was then denied a hat-trick when Bruton brilliantly tipped his right-footer over the bar. But the Blues always looked dangerous, on the break and Stuttle went narrowly wide, before his long throw produced a brave, diving save from Watson.

The Rec defence were putting on an heroic showing and held out until the fourth minute of stoppage time, when STUTTLE smashed a terrific, dipping shot over Watson, for a final score of 3-4.

An excellent all-round performance from Rec, with Man of the Match award going to Chris Long - two goals, won a penalty and worked his socks off for the team.
