



## Hamworthy Recreation Reserves made our way into the Dorset Premier League Cup Semi Final with a win over Holt Utd FC under the floodlights at the BJM Stadium.

The game started with both sides working each other out, both probing but not really putting either goalkeeper under much pressure, Ham Rec started to turn the screw on 20 mins and started to ask some questions of the Holt back line. on 23 mins the game opened with the first real chance, Ham Rec had the ball in the middle of the pitch, played it out to Brad Hill on the left wing who went 1v1 with the full back, unleashed a low shot but was well saved by REECE MITCHELL in the Holt goal. This spurred Rec on, and their efforts paid off on 33 mins, again the ball down the left-hand side, played out to the edge of the 18-yard box where ELLIOT BIRTWISTLE was waiting to calmly place the ball home into the far bottom corner, 1-0. The game opened up now with Holt on the looking for the equaliser, but Ham Rec held on to maintain the lead at half time.

#### HT 1-0

The second half started with a forced substation, BRAD HILL who had been brilliant on the left wing suffered an injury and couldn't start the 2nd half, he was replaced by MATT KERSE. Rec started the half on the front foot, maintaining possession and looking to exploit any space we could find, this paid off on 56 mins when Rec scored their 2nd goal with a fantastic team goal, HENRY BIRTWISTLE throw the ball out to GAVIN HAYNES on the edge of the Rec penalty area, Gavin drove into the space in front of him and saw the run of WILL LIPPIATT into space behind the Holt back line, a splitting ground pass had Will running at the Holt penalty area, Will picked out he run of HENRY BARHAM on the right wing, another drilled pass along the ground into Henrys path where he took a touch, passed it into DAN REEKS who calmly laid it back into Henrys path who had continued his run, with the ball just in front of him, Henry slid, clipped the ball over the out rushing REECE MITCHELL to double Rec's lead, 2-0. Holt were no means done, they continued to push and were rewarded with a goal on 70 mins, Holt were awarded a free kick on the edge of the Rec penalty area, the ball was floated in and dropped in between a crowd of players, it was eventually bundled home by a Holt player to make the score 2-1. The next 20 mins saw both side pushing for another goal until Holt were reduced to 10 men in the closing minutes, from them Rec controlled procession and tempo and saw the game out to a 2-1 win and move into the Semi Final!!

# Todays Opposition



The club was formed in 1898 as Swanage Albion Football Club, joining the Dorset Junior League and winning the Dorset Junior Cup in their first season.[2] The club then made it to the Dorset Senior League during the 1920s.[3] The 1920s also saw the club move from their original ground at Swanage Middle School, to Days Park and change their name to Swanage Town.[4]

In the 1957–58 season the club became one of the founder members of the Dorset Combination League.[5] The first season in the league proved very successful as the club became the leagues first winners.[6] The next five seasons saw the club finish in the top two, by winning the league three times in a row for the 1959–60, 1960–61 and 1961–62 campaigns, and finishing Runners up for the 1958–59, and 1962–63 seasons.[7] The 1961–62 campaign also saw the club enter the FA Cup for the first time in their history, losing to Bridport in the first qualifying round.[5]

In 1966 Swanage Town merged with local side Herston Rovers F.C., who had been

playing in the Dorset Combination league for five seasons, and the club was renamed Swanage Town & Herston F.C..[8] The club then stayed in the Dorset Combination League for another ten seasons, until the end of the 1975–76 competition when they left the league to join the newly reformed Division One of the Western Football League.[9]

After eleven seasons in Division the club gained promotion to the Premier Division, when they finished as Champions in the Division.[10] The 1989–90 campaign saw the club play their last season in the Western league as they then joined the Wessex Football League.[10] The last season in the Western league saw the club clinch the Dorset Senior Cup for the first and only time, when they beat Weymouth 1–0 in the final.[11] The first season in the Wessex Football League saw the club finish runners-up.[12] The 1990–91 season also saw the club reach the Dorset Senior Cup final

again, but this time lost to Weymouth 5-1.[13]

The 1995–96 season saw the club finish bottom of the Wessex league, and they were relegated back to the Dorset Combination league.[14] After four seasons in the Dorset Combination league, the club rejoined the Wessex league.[12] However they could only spend two seasons in the league as their second season back saw them finish bottom of the league and relegated to the Dorset Premier Football League[12][15] The 2007–08 season saw the club finish bottom of the Premier League, but they escaped relegation to the Dorset Football League as luckily for them there was no relegation that season.[3] Two seasons later the club under the management of Jason Phillips, became winners of the Dorset Premier Football League Cup.[3] In the 2016–17 season the Swans regained the Dorset Premier Football League Cup beating Gillingham Town reserves 2–0 in the final.
